Sepik River cruise description

The cruise aboard the Kalibobo Spirit up and downriver is basically the same except the villages you visit are in the reverse order. All cruise itineraries are subject to change depending on local and weather conditions.

Villages you can expect to visit include Perembei & Kanganaman famous for the maginficent Haus Tambarans (Spirit Houses), fine carvings and warm friendly people. The villages of Wombun and Aibom where you may see a drama performed by the youth at Wombun and pottery makers at Aibom.

At Kamindimbit you can normally see a demonstration of village life and cultural displays.



At Tambabum the largest village on the Sepik with superb houses and the people who are amongst the most prolific carvers on the Sepik.

At Kamabrindo a speeboat ride up to Mundox Village where you will witness village

life. The other villages in the Lower Sepik include Moim, Kambaramba, built on stilts in the backwater, Bien where a visit will be made to a community School and then to Murik Lakes by speedboat where you will visit Mendam. If weather conditions permit a stop at the volcanic island of Manam and possibly Buson Village on Kar Kar. Your final sector will be through the beautiful Madang Harbour.
